Old Business:

- 1. It appears the grass around the entrance is OK.
- 2. Fallen trees, behind Lots 64 & 61, damaged several areas of the fence. The DAB has an approximate \$600 bid for repairs. This will be added to the 2016 GPNCA budget.
- 3. A partial settlement with the Florida Dept. of Transportation, FDOT, regarding US Hwy 41, (FL SR 45) road work was made. A meeting of the GPNCA members will be held in the near future.
- 4. Irrigation system issues: Now OK but; the spray heads are getting old and damaged.

 We decided to have the system checked thoroughly every 3 months, except Nov.

 thru March. Don will ask Dick Lemma for a recommended licensed/bonded vendor.
- 5. Aliz Dalyai's house exterior, at Lot 55, has been painted.

- 6. The recently installed new sign lights, at the entrance, flicker when headlights are aimed at it. The contractor has been contacted to try to fix the problem.
- 7. All 4 overhead main entrance light bulbs will be replaced.

New Business:

- 1. A GPN member has made a complaint about the neighbors' bushes encroaching on his property. The bushes were planted without DAB approval. The DAB will not get involved, as we did not provide approval. Tim will respond to the complainant.
- 2. The wooden railing around the Rainbow Spring models' parking lot will be removed.
- 3. Estimated additional costs for the 2016 GPNCA budget are: Irrigation repair, \$500; Tree removal, \$2000; Fence repair, \$650 and Pressure Washing entrance, \$400.
